

# NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

## GERMAN MILLS CREEK EMERGENCY MAINTENANCE FOR INTERIM SANITARY PROTECTION WORKS

**Start Date:** Late September 2018

**Completion Date:** October 2018

*\*Timeline is subject to change*

Toronto and Region Conservation Authority (TRCA), in partnership with the Regional Municipality of York, is preparing to implement emergency maintenance for interim sanitary protection works within German Mills Park, south of John Street and Don Mills Road, in the City of Markham. Storm events in summer of 2018 have exposed the sanitary sewer adjacent to German Mills Creek. Emergency maintenance is required to stabilize the exposed infrastructure until scheduled works can be implemented in 2020, as planned under a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment.

The sanitary protection works are tentatively scheduled to commence in late September 2018, pending the receipt of all necessary permits and approvals. Construction is anticipated to be completed in October 2018. Construction access will be provided from the park entrance at John Street. Please note the trail will be closed during work hours and will be reopened during evenings and weekends.

For your safety, please respect all posted construction signs and stay clear of the work areas and equipment. Your continued cooperation and patience is appreciated.
