## Gatineau Hydro Corridor Project, Sir Sandford Fleming College, Ecosystem Management Students

TRCA engaged a group of third year Ecosystem Management Technology students from Sir Sandford Fleming College to design a conceptual plan for meadow pollinator habitats.

These meadow plots will be part of a larger, long-term project to enhance approximately 16 km of hydro corridor in the GTA.

Students met with TRCA staff to assess the area, make note of local flora and fauna and develop ideas for meadow plot sites. This area will be the site of native wildflower plantings with local residents and community groups to provide much needed habitat for declining pollinator species.
