Valleywood Cliffview Court, Pollinator Habitat Enhancement with Local Residents

A group of Brampton Girl Guides and local residents attended the newly established meadow plot at Valleywood, Cliffview Ct to assist with a pollinator meadow plot enhancement and planting event. The group planted 70 native wildflowers to provide necessary habitat for local pollinators which are declining globally.

This is the second meadow plot established in this area. The group also established 5 pollinator structures to assist with providing necessary nesting sites. By providing native wildflowers which bloom year round, pollinators will continue to flourish at this site.

Local residents and community groups have been actively involved in the maintenance of these plots along with additional stewardship activities including; cleanup events to remove household litter and illegal dumping and planting native trees and shrubs.

Being actively involved in these types of activities allow residents a better understanding of natural spaces, local wildlife and the importance of protecting these areas.
