## Valleywood Etobicoke Creek Trail Extension Opening Ceremony

Taking a long hike along the Etobicoke Creek Trail is a whole lot easier now thanks to the collaborative efforts of Toronto and Region Conservation (TRCA), City of Brampton, Town of Caledon, Region of Peel and the Ministry of Transportation.

Dignitaries, TRCA staff and members of local cycling groups were on hand to celebrate the extension of the Etobicoke Creek Trail link with a short ceremony and ribbon cutting.

The completed trail link is the realization of a dream to allow Etobicoke Creek Trail users a continuous path from the City of Brampton to the Town of Caledon. Through funding and contributions from the City of Brampton, Town of Caledon, Region of Peel, TRCA and the Ontario Municipal Cycling Infrastructure Program, more than 1,500 m of new trail was created, including a new trailhead kiosk.
