# South Mimico Pedestrian Trail Project



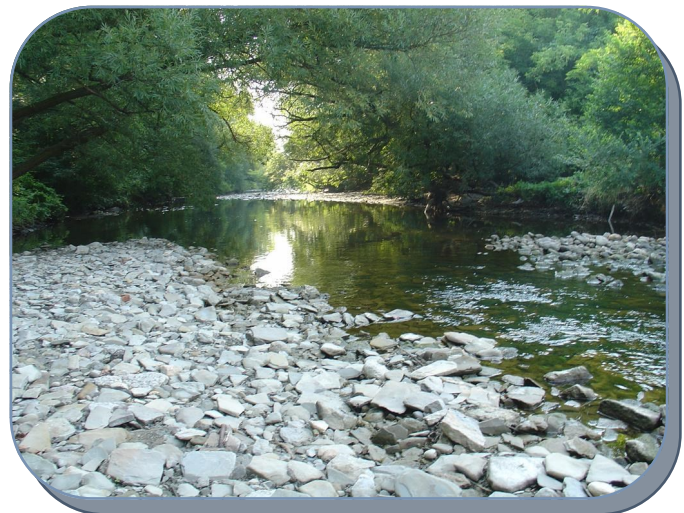
### Project Description:

TRCA and City of Toronto have long supported a trail connection linking Mimico Creek Trail system to the waterfront but various factors had prevented this initiative from moving forward. Recent developments with respect to re-zoning of properties along Mimico Creek from commercial/industrial to residential

within the project area have alleviated some of these barriers.

Through these new developments, TRCA and City of Toronto have developed a concept plan for a public trail link along this reach of Mimico Creek. TRCA has been working closely with City of Toronto through the planning process to secure additional funding support and the necessary lands to support this trail connection. The proposed project is approximately 1200 meters in length, including three pedestrian crossings which will link northern trails and open spaces to developing neighborhoods and parklands along Lakeshore Boulevard and the waterfront.

Plans also include opportunities for restoration to enhance vegetation along the riparian zone and mitigation of erosion along creek banks to prevent sedimentation which is a threat to aquatic species.
