Etobicoke Creek Trail Link at Pinebrook Circle Caledon

In 2016, Phase I of a 1,500 metre trail extension was implemented from Mayfield Rd to the Hwy #410 overpass creating an important inter-regional trail connection between the Town of Caledon and City of Brampton.

In 2017, TRCA working with residential developer Argo Caledon Corporation and the Town of Caledon, completed construction of Valleywood Phase 2 trail project.

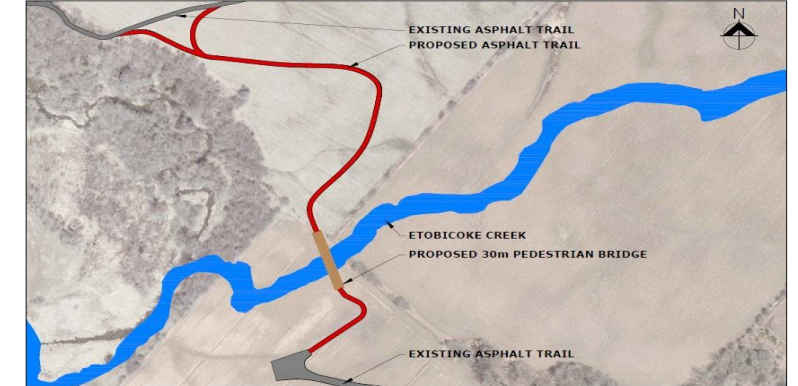
A new 600 metre trail link and pedestrian crossing in Caledon links the existing communities off of Pinebrook Circle with the new communities in the Mayfield West residential development off of Valleybrook Crescent. This new trail extension creates another important recreational and active transportation connection for local residents, creates access for residents to enjoy the Etobicoke Creek Valley and will help reduce the amount of informal trails that are created through the delicate valleylands.

Over the next couple of years, TRCA staff will be organizing community based restoration activities along the new trail to help enhance riparian cover along the Etobicoke Creek, mitigate impacts of erosion, improve habitat connectivity within the valleylands and engage local residents in stewardship activities.
