

NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

Wilket Creek Rehabilitation Project — Reach 2

Start Date: Late June 2018

Completion Date: February 2019

**Timeline is subject to change*

Toronto and Region Conservation Authority (TRCA), on behalf of the City of Toronto, is undertaking the next phase of work in Wilket Creek Park to protect municipal infrastructure and public safety against the hazards of stream erosion. This phase of work involves a combination of channel realignment, bank and bed stabilization, pedestrian bridge installation, and trail improvements.

Construction for this phase is anticipated to be completed in February 2019, with final site restoration to follow in spring 2019 as weather permits.

The trail will be temporarily reopened from December 20, 2018 until January 1, 2019, and on weekends starting January 5, 2019 until the completion of construction. While the trail is open, it is to be used with caution, as there may be uneven surfaces present and no winter maintenance along the trail.

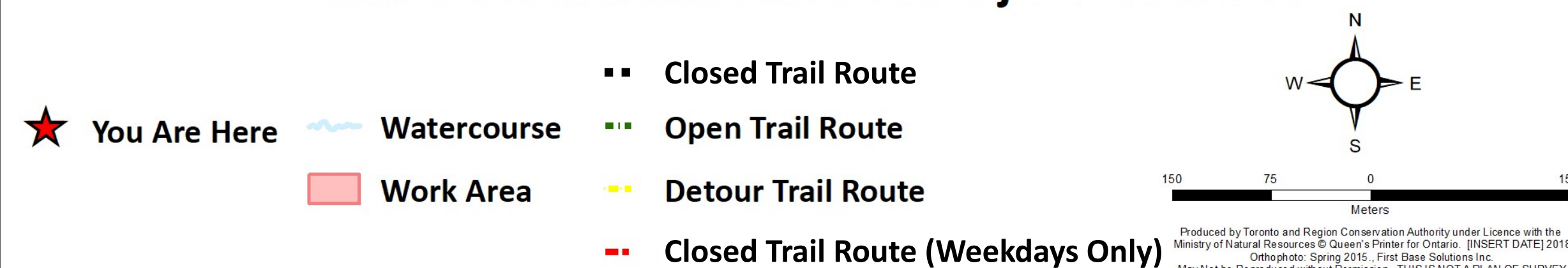
