

NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

East Don Trail Project—Phase 1

Start Date: September 2018

Completion Date: December 2019*

**Timeline is subject to change due to suitable weather and site conditions*

Toronto and Region Conservation Authority (TRCA) and the City of Toronto are constructing a 3.1 km asphalt multi-use recreational trail between Bermondsey Road and Taylor Creek Park in the Don River valley lands.

The new trail will include:

- . five permanent pedestrian bridges over the East Don River;
- . bank stabilization and site drainage improvements;
- . a boardwalk, resting nodes, benchfit, railings, way-finding signage, a tunnel and overhead pedestrian bridge;
- . paving, site restoration works and tree plantings.

Construction work will involve:

- . closure of Taylor Creek parking lot;
- . intermittent closure of Taylor Creek Dog Off-leash Park;
- . temporary fencing, erosion and sediment controls;
- . installation of five temporary construction bridges;
- . tree removals and tree protection;
- . on-site storage areas.

What to expect during construction:

- . moderate dust, noise and temporary closures of existing informal trails;
- . residents should follow construction signs and directives around areas of construction to maintain personal safety;
- . the TRCA and City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on public property.
