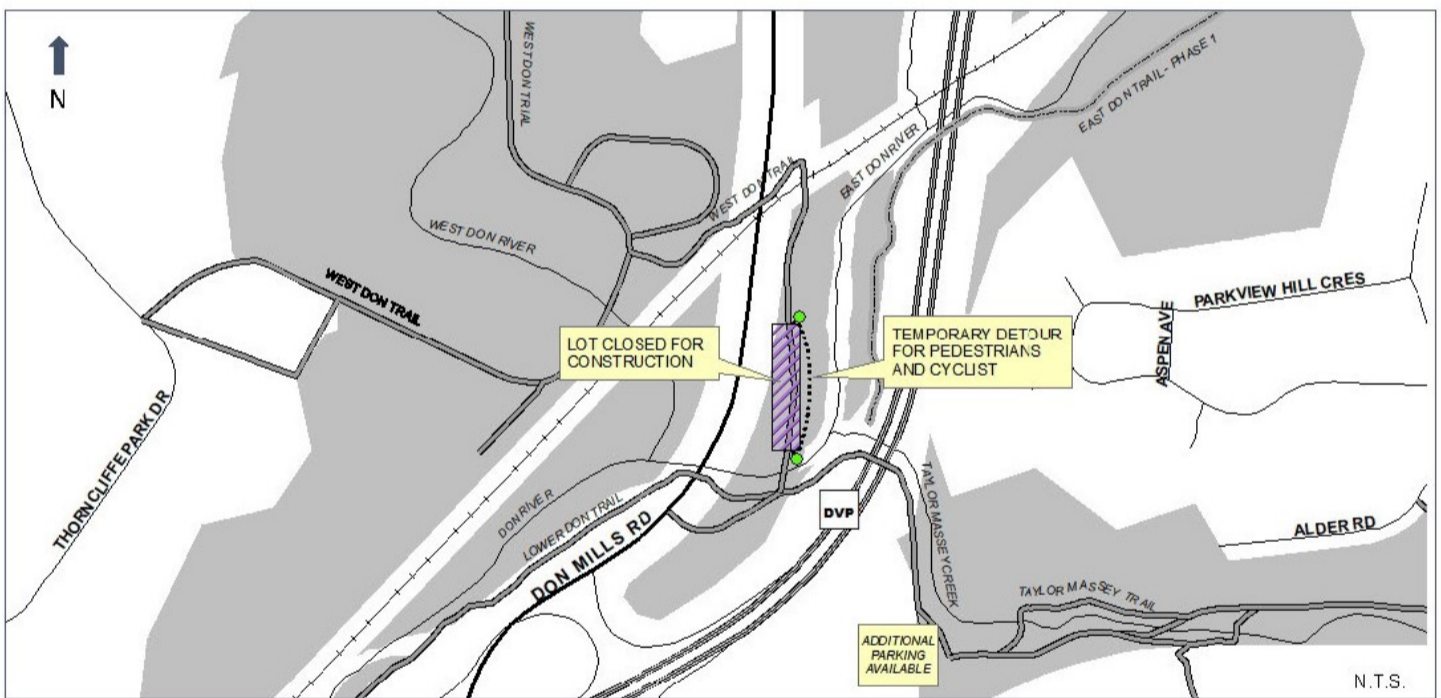

The West Don Parking Lot Improvement Project is being completed by the City of Toronto in partnership with the Toronto and Region Conservation Authority (TRCA). The purpose of the project is to provide additional parking and provide a three metre wide paved multi-use trail to improve separation between vehicles and cyclist/pedestrians within the area as shown on the map below.

WORK DETAILS




Equipment, materials and crews will be on-site beginning in September 2018 and will prepare the work areas before construction begins. Construction access will be via the existing park access road off the east side of Don Mills Road, over the existing bridge over the East Don River. **The work will include the following:**

- Install perimeter fencing, erosion and sediment controls, signage and tree protection barriers
- Prepare construction staging and stockpile areas for equipment and material storage (to be located within the existing parking lot)
- Tree removals, excavation, and installation of gravel base along proposed trail alignment
- Install drainage swales to improve site drainage
- Install concrete curbs and granular base
- Install new resting node including bollards, bench and signage

- Site paving and restoration including topsoil, seeding and compensation plantings
- Dust and debris removal will be done at construction entrances and adjacent roadways as required throughout the duration of the project

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience moderate dust and noise near work areas
- There will be temporary closures of the existing parking lot including the connection to the Lower Don trail west of Don Mills Road from Taylor Creek Park. The City and TRCA will make every effort to reduce these impacts. We appreciate your patience in this regard
- Public parking will be available in the existing Dog Off-Leash parking lot located on the south side of the Don Valley Parkway
- Park users shall follow construction signs and directives around areas of construction to maintain personal safety along the proposed temporary route as shown on the site map
- Cyclists will be required to dismount while using the temporary route around the work area
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7:00 am to 5:00 pm., Monday to Friday. After hour and weekend work will be minimized whenever possible to avoid disruptions.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers and park users. Park users may experience delays and increased traffic on park entrances and roadways.</p>
	<p>Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at 416-808-2222.</p>
