No Motor Vehicle Access to Taylor Creek Trail from Don Mills Road

The City's contractor requires access to the current construction site in the parking lot located in Coxwell Ravine Park as part of the Don River & Central Waterfront Flow System. Motor vehicle access between Don Mills Road and the Coxwell Bypass Tunnel Construction site will be immediately restricted until further notice. Access for cyclists and pedestrians will be maintained. **Any motor vehicles parked along Taylor Creek Trail may be towed.**


